

GETAC STROKE COMMITTEE NOTES

The GETAC STROKE COMMITTEE met on Feb 24, 2009 at 1030am in Austin. Here is brief summary of that meeting.

The schedule for the Stroke Rule is on track. A copy of the import dates are listed on the NCTTRAC website System development page.

The question of “in active pursuit” was raised and will be discussed at depth at the May meeting with most of the conversation leaving the responsibility to each RAC.

The question of when applications will be accepted and when the state will issue the Stroke certifications was also raised. At this time the state is giving a 30 day turn around time from when they receive the application to the issuance of the certification. The possibility of the State receiving applications in July 2009 was discussed and will be discussed at greater detail in future meetings.

Level III Stroke designation Criteria and survey process will be worked on in May and August with the State and TETAF.

Pediatric stroke was discussed and was deferred to each RAC. Dr Sheehan will be gathering information for the committee to review.
