In order to vote, your organization must have an approved 2010 Membership Application and have paid 2010 dues.

NCTTRAC Bylaws

ARTICLE XIV

Proxies

14.1 A voting member can be represented by proxy.

14.1.1 Such proxy shall be originated and/or signed by the member's primary designated voting representative and filed with the Secretary or designee of NCTTRAC prior to the meeting as defined in the related NCTTRAC SOP.

14.1.2 Such proxy shall be assigned to an individual that is employed by the same organization or corporation as the voting member assigning proxy.

14.1.3 No individual shall hold more than one proxy at a time, unless granted between members within the same corporation.

14.1.4 No such proxy shall be valid after the expiration of ninety (90) days from the date of its execution or as otherwise specified.

SOP – Voting at General Membership Meetings

- All designated voting members will identify themselves and sign in as a voting member at the registration booth prior to each General Membership meeting. If the person signing in as the voting member is not listed on the NCTTRAC list, that person must have written, signed, and dated statement from the official voting member which designates this person as a proxy for the specified meeting. This statement may be faxed or sent by e-mail to the NCTTRAC Office Manager no later than 4 days prior to the meeting.
- Only designated voting members or their proxy will be given a written ballot or voting card.
